HAWAIIAN QUILT BLOCK – one day



In this class, you will have hands-on experience with cutting out a Hawaiian block, basting, and needle turn appliqué. Hawaiian quilts are deeply rooted in tradition, with designs inspired by nature and native customs. These quilts typically feature symmetrical medallion centres, appliquéd from a single piece of fabric onto a contrasting background.

Although we'll focus on creating a single block during the workshop, you'll leave with the skills and knowledge needed to complete an entire quilt block on your own. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced quilter, this workshop will provide you with the techniques and confidence to craft your own visually stunning Hawaiian quilt.

During this hands-on class, you will learn how to cut out a Hawaiian quilt block, baste your fabric and master the art of needle turn appliqué.

Supply List:

- Embroidery Scissors
- 60-80wt (applique') cotton thread
- Flathead pins
- Hand quilting thread
- Sharp needles size #9-10
- Needle threader (optional)
- Thimble (optional)

Kit includes: all material necessary to complete a 12" square Hawaiian block (quilt block template, backing fabric, wadding and access to a selection of Kaffe Fassett's fabrics for the top, instructions to complete your project).
