**Please do not bring your own Sewing Machine to this class.**

## **Fabric requirements for the Faced Binding Workshop:**

For this workshop you'll need to prepare or bring three finished Quilts (top – batting – back) that are at least 12 x 12 inch. You could also prepare a few table sets that you want to finish by learning three different ways of faced binding. You won't be able to finish binding three large quilts, but some might be able to finish binding smaller quilts.

For Quilt 1:

2 x 2.5 inch stripes of fabric (color matches the front of the Quilt) that are the width of the quilt and 2 x 2.5 inch stripes of fabric (color matches the front of the Quilt) that war the length of the quilt.

For Quilt 2:

2 x 2.5 inch stripes of fabric (color matches the front of the Quilt) that are the width of the quilt and 2 x 2.5 inch stripes of fabric (color matches the front of the Quilt) that war the length of the quilt.

For Quilt 3:

4 x 5 inch squares of facric (color matches the front of the Quilt)  
2 x 2.5 inch stripes of fabric (color matches the front of the Quilt) that are the width of the quilt and 2 x 2.5 inch stripes of fabric (color matches the front of the Quilt) that war the length of the quilt.

For the hanging sleeves:

One piece of 8 inch fabric for each quilt that measures the width of the quilt.

## **Equipment requirements for the Faced Binding Workshop:**

- Sewing-Machine
- ¼ inch sewing foot
- Good quality Thread in an appropriate weight for piecing
- Chalk marker or Water Soluble Pen for Fabric
- Large Rotary Cutter - with a new blade
- Spray starch or another ironing aid
- Ironing Clapper
- Wonderclips
- Corner and edge sharpener or a knitting needle size 4 or 5
- Cutting-Mat
- Large Patchwork Ruler at least 12 inch long
- Fabric Scissors
- Safety Pins
- Thread cutter
- Handsewing needle and thread
- Thread gloss
