PATTERN

A copy of my pattern, Therapy and Metamorphosis, is needed for class. You may download a copy of the pattern at my website, www.pattymurphyhandmade.com

EACH STUDENT IS REQUIRED TO HAVE A COPY OF THE PATTERN FOR CLASS.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS*

LIGHT: 2 1/2 yards

MEDIUM: 6 3/4 yards

DARK: 1 1/2 yards

SCRAPS FOR DIAMONDS: approximately 6 yards

*This pattern allows for extra fabric to allow movement in the quilt.

*If you use an ombré fabric, you will need about 9 yards of a mirrored ombré (dark selvedge edges, light at the fold).

NOTIONS AND TOOLS

1/4" foot

Add-A-Quarter ruler

Batting for design wall

Elmer's glue stick

Flat head pins

Iron

Needles - size 90/14

Pin Cushion

Pressing surface

Rotary cutter - 45 mm or 60mm

Rotary Mat - 18" x 24" works great!

Rulers:

24" x 6" or 24 1/2" x 6 1/2" ruler

Square ruler - minimum size 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Scissors



NOTIONS AND TOOLS, CONT.

Seam Ripper

Sewing machine in good working order - don't forget power cord or presser foot!

Spare needles for your sewing machine

Straight pins

Thread

You will also need a postcard, cereal box board, comic book board or any light weight cardboard for folding. This is for folding the pattern on itself to trim your 1/4" seam allowance. ANY of those items will work. Just use what you have on hand!)

PREP FOR CLASS

PATTERN PREP

Please print 50 copies of the foundation piecing pattern (page 14) BEFORE class. You can find the template in the pdf pattern download. I recommend you print on newprint. You can find that online or at your local office supply store.

Please print and cut out templates A, B and C. Glue them on cardboard, comic book board, or cut a copy from template plastic. You can use the paper template, but I find the templates hold up better if they are on a more solid substrate.

FABRIC PREP

To maximize our sewing time, please starch and cut your fabric before class.
