FABRIC REQUIREMENTS*

Center/Grey: 1/3 yard

Purple: 7/8 yard

Blue: 1 2/3 yard

Pink: 1 3/4 yard

Green: 2 1/8 yard

*you may use any color combination of fabrics you'd like

NOTIONS AND TOOLS

1/4" foot

Batting for design wall

Iron

Pin Cushion

Pressing surface

Rotary cutter - 45 mm or 60mm

Rotary Mat - 18" x 24" works great!

Rulers:

24" x 6" or 24 1/2" x 6 1/2" ruler

Square ruler - minimum size 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Scissors

Seam Ripper

Sewing machine in good working order - don't forget power cord or presser foot!

Spare needles for your sewing machine

Starch or starch alternative

Straight pins

Thread



PREP FOR CLASS

To maximize our time, please cut fabric according to directions on page 24 of Zero Waste Quilting.

OF NOTE

This quilt was made using scraps. The more fabrics you include, the more movement and depth you will create. The colors don't all have to match perfectly but they need to place nicely together. Think you want to include a fabric but you aren't sure? Just bring it to class and we can discuss how to incorporate it.

additionally, if you are uneasy about cutting all the strips, cut some and bring your fabric to class. We can cut more pieces during our time together.
