

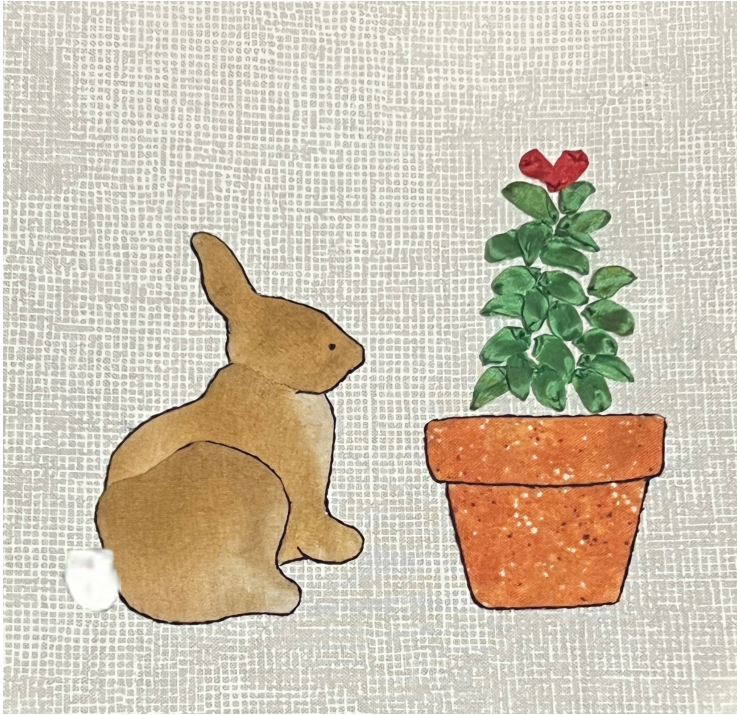

Creating Sweet and Simple Appliqué Motifs



During this 2-day hand-appliqué workshop, David will show you how to make a pattern for a simple appliqué motif, storybook-style! Day one will focus on pattern drawing, making freezer paper templates and fabric preparation. Day two will cover hand stitching and embellishment.

STUDENT SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Inspiration photos or drawings of animals or plants suitable for recreating with hand appliqué.
- Paper scissors and fabric scissors
- Mini iron and ironing surface
- Hand appliqué needle
- Hand-sewing thread
- Appliqué pins
- Pencil or mechanical pencil
- Finger stiletto – (trolley needle, optional, but very useful)

STUDENT LAB FEE: \$25

Lab fee provides access to instructor provided materials including, but not limited to: freezer paper sheets, brushes, starch, tracing paper for pattern creation, fabric, silk ribbons and floss.
